 - h) totally aware of heavy equipment around you
 - i) working around dust
 - j) working around borrow pits
 - k) working on rough terrain, ditches, etc.
 - l) working in the rain, "driving conditions, walking conditions"

2. Crew Chief should communicate with contractor foreman regarding work assignments around equipment daily.

- signage

19.1 SURVEYING ON ROADWAYS

- ◆ Park in a visible area on the shoulder of the roadway.
- ◆ Use the vehicles to provide protection from behind.
- ◆ Activate flashing lights on vehicle.
- ◆ Wear the personal protective equipment as required.
- ◆ Set up traffic warning signs as required.
- ◆ Try to keep instruments and vehicles off the traveled roadway whenever possible.
- ◆ All workers on crew to monitor for oncoming traffic.
- ◆ Be aware of visible hazards along right of ways (traffic power lines, fences, etc.)
- ◆ Whenever possible use offset baselines.
- ◆ Try to work facing oncoming traffic.
- ◆ If possible, change the hours of work to match lower traffic volume periods.
- ◆ Use caution when working in tall grass, etc. and be wary of hidden dangers.
